WA9GON & John, NZ9Z for bringing projection equipment and Thanks to Fred, W6BSF for the one hour video -- K5D – dx pedition to DESECHEO ISLAND which is 21 km or 15 minutes by helicopter from Puerto Rico. Desecheo Island once a bombing range became a National Wildlife Refuge in 1983 with limited access – special permission had to be received for the dx pedition to take place. The island is under the control of the Dept of Interior – Fish & Wildlife Service. The dx pedition took place February 12-26, 2009 and made 115,787 Q's. This was an excellent video program.
